FEES AND POLICIES

Augusta Country Club Masters Week unaccompanied guest fee: \$2,500/tee time. Fee includes all golf fees, guest fees, cart fees, range fees, forecaddie fees, forecaddie tip and taxes. The players may choose to tip the forecaddie additionally if they feel he has gone above and beyond expectations. Once the tee time is booked it will be billed to the reciprocal club immediately. Payment for the tee time must be received within 30 days or the tee time will be cancelled. Tee times are considered guaranteed at time of booking. No refunds will be issued for reciprocal tee times.

BAG DROP

Upon entering the club, the first right will lead you to the North parking lot and the golf bag drop area.

LOCKER ROOMS

Guests are required to change their shoes in the member locker rooms. A locker will be provided for you by our locker room staff.

CHECK-IN & GUEST CARD

Please check-in with the Golf Shop at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time. Each group will receive one guest card to be used for any food & beverage purchases while on property.

CELL PHONES

The use of cellular phones is allowed but they should be set on silent or vibrate. When using a cell phone, please move to a private area in order to not disturb others.

PACE OF PLAY

All golfers are expected to complete their round within 4 hours or less.

DRESS CODE

Appropriate golfing attire is required on the golf course and driving range. Appropriate golfing attire includes:

MEN:

- Slacks or Bermuda length shorts (no denim or cargo)
- Collared shirts
- Golf shoes must have non-metal spikes

WOMEN:

- Slacks or Bermuda length shorts, skirts or culottes (no denim)
- Shirts may be collared or crewnecked
- Sleeveless tops are permitted
- Golf shoes must have non-metal spikes

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Guests are welcome to use the driving range, short game area and practice putting green before their round of golf.
